- Photograph of the subject property
- Photograph of adjacent property
- Photograph of specific areas of the building to be modified
- Site Plan
- Clear description of modification(s) proposed, with specifications of material and color
- Drawing or photograph of the modification(s) proposed
- Copy of catalogue depiction of modification, if available
- Sample of colors, from paint supplier

Environmental regulations according to the California Environmental Quality Act may also require additional review.

Depending on the scope of work, some projects can be approved administratively by staff, while others may require review by the Cultural Heritage Commission.
